Like most, we have been carefully monitoring the progression and have been strictly following the advice of both Canada and US public health authorities. We will be in close contact with each of them and look forward to having them back to help host your next night out when we reopen.

In addition, all restaurant support staff have shifted to more flexible working arrangements in an effort to provide top-notch preventative measures at our corporate offices.
